Coaches Code of Conduct

I as a Coach with CHJAAF agree to adhere to the following:

I agree that the CHJAAF football program is for the kids and should be free of adult ambition.

I will not use profanity, smoke or drink at any practice or game in accordance with the IEJAAF Conference rulebook.

I will not berate any game officials, conference or league officials at any time.

At any time, I will not have any violent physical contact with a player.

I understand that I am governed by the IEJAAF conference rulebook and any violation can result in suspension or expulsion from the program

I agree to abide by the 5-play minimum play rule in accordance with the conference rule book AND to agree to the 3-play minimum play rule for all "Playoff Games" in accordance with the CHJAAF Bylaws.

I understand the Commissioner and/or Athletic Director has the right to question and/or intercede on behalf of the league or parents of any child in the CHJAAF program

I agree that I must complete any mandated Conference Clinics and have all processed paperwork on file prior to participating in any practice and/or game on behalf of CHJAAF.

I understand that as a Head Coach, I am responsible for the actions of all coaches on my staff.

I understand that CHJAAF has the right to suspend or expel my membership from the organization for rule violations in accordance with its Bylaws.

A copy of this signed document must be on file with the Commissioner prior to participating in any practice or game on behalf of CHJAAF.

I/We will not use profanity, tobacco products or alcoholic beverages at any practice or game field in accordance with the IEJAAF Conference rulebook. Violation of this rule can result in suspension from the league for my family including my child.

I/We will not approach or berate any game officials, league officials and/or conference board members. Violation of this rule can result in suspension from the league for my family including my child.

I/We agree to abide by the 24-hour "cool down" period prior to discussing concerns with my child's coaches after a game.

I/We understand that fighting is not tolerated and will result in immediate suspension or termination from the league.

I/We agree that the CHJAAF football program is for the kids and should be free of adult ambition.

Games



- When
 - Saturdays
 - 1st Game: Sept 12th
- Where
 - Home games during the regular season are held at Ayala High School or Chino Hills High.
 - New Fields Turf Field = New Rules.
 - Away games are spread throughout the Inland Empire.
 - Furthest city Hesperia (North) – Cathedral City (East)
 - Come out to the Games. Sometimes we had more visiting parents, than Home Fans.

Playoffs



Based on your teams overall record you could be in the playoffs. The IEJAAF playoffs are single elimination games through the Championship.

- When
 - Saturdays at the conclusion of the regular season.
- Where
 - Neutral game sites.
 - Individual chapters bid on hosting playoff games in August of the previous season.

Rules to Note



- 5 Play Min by end of 3rd Qtr in regular Season
- Three plays in the play offs before the end of the game
- Parent / Player / Coach Code of Conduct must be signed prior to paper certification: Aug 22nd
- One Weigh In for all players in San Bernardino Aug 29th. If the player doesn't make weight he/she will be moved to the next division when possible. Not there = Miss the 1st game.
- Scholar Athlete – Conference will award a patch for each football or cheer leader with a 3.0 or higher.

Team Selection Process



The selection process for all team divisions except Midget is a draft. Players will be evaluated and drafted on teams based on skill level.

- **No guarantee of placement with friends.**
- **Siblings will play on same Div (1,2), unless parents request otherwise.**
- **Minimum play is 5 plays prior to the end of the 3rd Quarter. Minimum 3 Plays throughout the Play Offs.**
- **Goal is to place players on a team where they can learn and get game experience.**

Practice Information



- Requirements to Practice
 - Physical (All players)
 - Signed Contracts (All players)
 - Birth Certificate (All players)
 - Proof of Residence (New players)
- Attendance
 - Players are expected to be fully dressed and ready to begin practice at 6:00 pm.
 - We must be off the field by 8:00 pm for other team practices.
 - Pick up kids by 8:20 or they will be dropped off at the sheriffs station.
 - For your kids safety and well-being please be on time for both pick up and drop off. Planned absence within the first two weeks of practice, please see Teresa Aerts in the back of the room.

Equipment



- First Week (10 Hours)
 - Black Shorts
 - Plain white T-shirt or Grey Spirit pack T-shirt with LAST NAME in black letters on front and back
 - Non-detachable molded rubber cleats
 - White socks
 - Standard Mouth Guard
 - Soft or Hard Cup (Sons & Daughters)
 - Helmet w/cheek pads (2), chin strap

 - Practice Jersey
